#### **Location and Hotel Fees**

The God is a Wonder Spiritual Retreat & Restoration Conference will be held on the campus of Ebenezer A.M.E. Church, in Fort Washington, MD. Hotel accommodations are available at the National harbor located on the expansive waterfront of the Potomac River just minutes from the church. Lodging must be arranged separately and can be secured at one of several partner hotels at the beautiful National Harbor.

When calling to make your reservation, you must mention **Ebenezer A.M.E. Church** to receive the discounted rate. Be sure to make your reservations as early as possible since there are only a limited number of rooms available. The deadline to book rooms is **Wednesday, April 30, 2024**. Please do not wait until the deadline as rooms are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once these rooms are gone, we cannot guarantee the discounted rates.

All reservations must be guaranteed with a one night non-refundable deposit at the time you reserve your room. Based on current banking procedures, use of a debit card for hotel check-in transactions and rental cars is discouraged. This could result in additional funds being withheld for an extended period of time. Additionally, please **DO NOT** send your hotel registration to Ebenezer A.M.E. Church.

#### **Transportation**

Charter buses, vans and vehicles will be available to transport attendees from the National Harbor property to Ebenezer A.M.E. Church for a cost of only \$85 for the entire weekend. Pre-registration for transportation services is required. On-site registration will not be available.

#### **Travel Arrangements**

There are three major airports that serve this region--Reagan National Airport is the closest to the designated hotels. Dulles International Airport and Thurgood Marshall Baltimore-Washington International Airport are approximately one hour away. Amtrak Train Service is also available to New Carrollton, MD and Washington, DC, which are within 30 minutes of the retreat hotels by taxi.

#### Meals

ALL MEALS are on your own. There will be vendors available to purchase food on-site and a list of local restaurants will be provided.

#### **Identification Badges**

You must wear your badge for admission to all activities. The registration badge provides access to all retreat activities, including meals. A fee will be charged to replace any lost badges.
